Tom's ex up to old tricks

LUANN de Lesseps soon-to-be-ex-husband returned to the "scene of the crime" this week.

Tom D'Agostino — who split with the "Real Housewives of New York City" star in August after seven months of marriage — was spotted leaving the Regency Hotel on the Upper East Side on Wednesday and getting into a car with two blond women and a man, we're told.

Fans of the Bravo show will recall that D'Agostino got in trouble last year because of an evening at the Regency with a different blonde.

There was an enormous uproar after **Bethenny Frankel** revealed that D'Agostino was caught kissing ex-girlfriend **Missy Pool** at the hotel on the night before an engagement

party for him and de Lesseps.
